community and involvement in the community," said Maso, who added that if Briarcliff wins the money it will go toward bringing more art programs to the school.

Briarcliff Elementary currently only has a part-time art teacher, leaving the students to have art only once a week. "That's a short time. So, we are hoping with this money we could bring in another program, or bring in even more supplies. [\$5,000 is] more than what they get now for the year," Maso said.

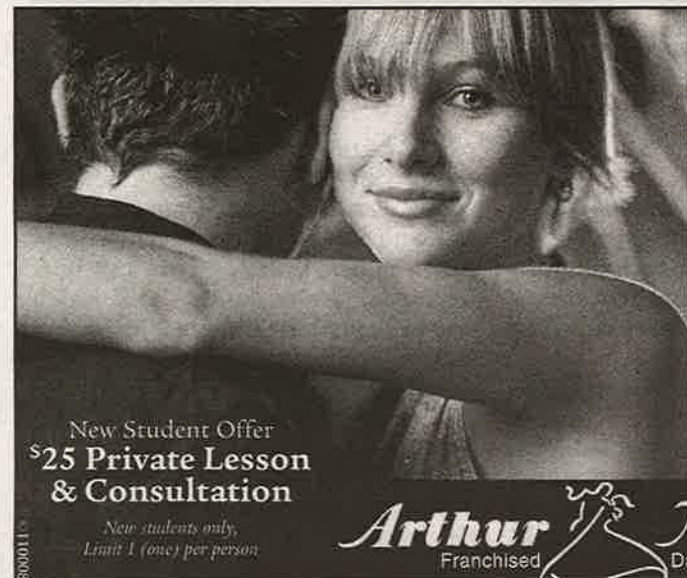
Maso said at the elementary level, art is critical for the students and she is fighting to enhance it. "It gives the kids a sense of creativity. You see how excited they get ... It just shows their imagination and their love. It's a great

way for them to express themselves, which is really important for children."

Kiara and Makayla Maso, who are twins, said they were excited to help paint. "We are painting all of these windows ... I just like it because it's fun," Kiara said. Makayla said she likes the painting. "If we win, we are going to have a celebration," Makayla said.

Principal Jane Ruthkowski came out to show her support for the students. "We constantly talk about being good citizens and the six pillars of good character as being responsible and showing respect. These types of activities reinforce those types of pillars," she said.
